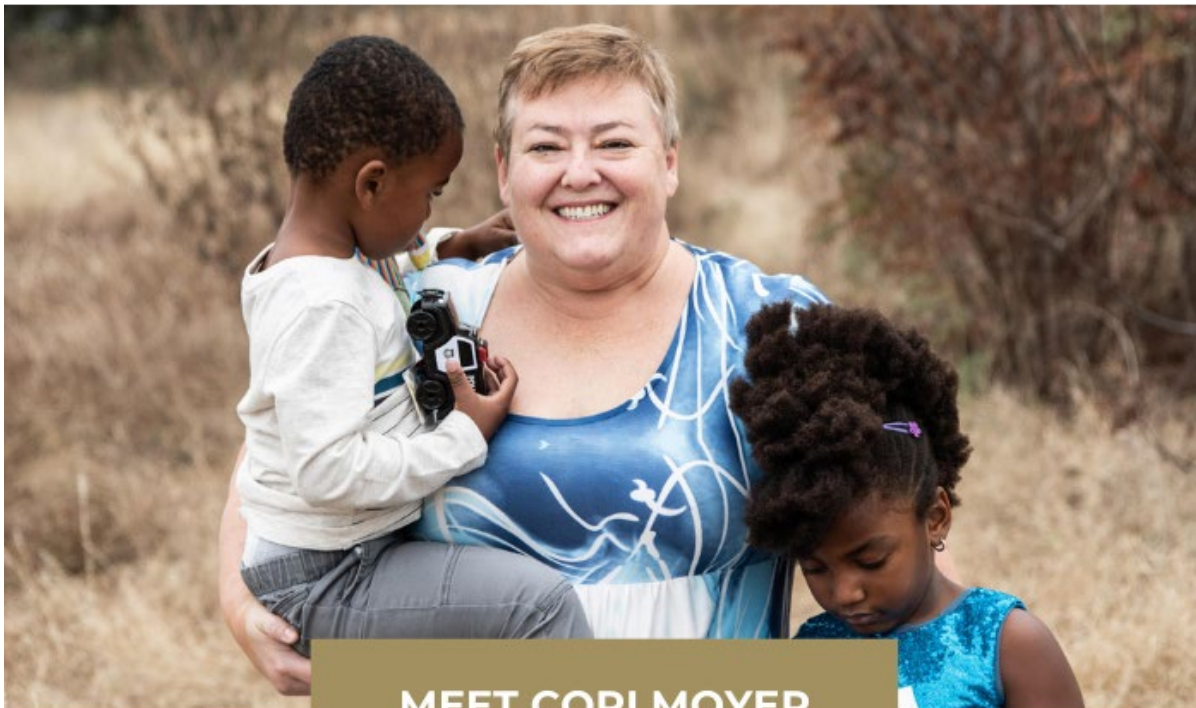


Subject: Lynne, THIS is the impact that you are making ✨

Did you know? You have helped children go to school.

Djeneba Traoré didn’t get to start school until she was 13 years old. From age 6 to 13, she was 124 miles from her parents, helping her older sister take care of her children and pan for gold. Back home, Djeneba’s younger siblings got to start school. Imagine what that must have been like for her—knowing her siblings were learning without her.

On a trip back home, Djeneba asked her parents if she could stay and go to school. Her father says "I was torn between joy and disgrace. Joy because she was replacing her older brothers who had all dropped out of school because of the strikes of the last few years. Disgrace, because I felt guilty for her late schooling. **But everything is back in order, that's the most important thing.**"

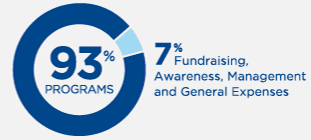

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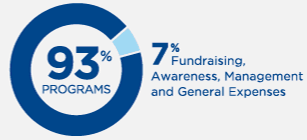
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Subject: Fun findings on MCHT preserves

I was recently asked what my favorite part of being a steward was, and my answer came out faster than I can think. "I love being outside," I said, simple as that.

Time outside is time to learn, and the lessons come fast and furious when you're out in the elements. While monitoring easements, working trail maintenance, or leading outreach adventures with humans of all ages—I'm always searching for birds, mushrooms, mammals, bugs, butterflies... you name it. Of course, "nature bumming" extends beyond work hours, spilling into just about any moment of free time I have. I love finding natural treasures.
