## NAMED Learning Center continues to make an important difference 2 messages

Dear members of the NAMED family,

We continue to be so grateful to your family for endowing the **NAMED** Learning Center, which continues to be a hub for student support and innovative resources that enhance the experience for all students and teachers. I thought you would appreciate seeing just one of the ways the Learning Center supports **all** Lower School students.

Designed by the Lower School Learning Center Specialists in consultation with our occupational therapist and JK-Grade 1 teachers, the <u>sensory pathway</u> offers activities that reset the proprioceptive and vestibular system, meaning each piece of the sensory path is designed to help students improve their body awareness (proprioceptive) and support balance and spatial orientation (vestibular).

When these sensory systems are working optimally, students have improved cognition, and are more available for learning. It has already helped many students who need to increase their energy levels as well as those who need to settle their bodies so they can tackle new projects and tasks within the classroom.

Lower School teachers have already seen the benefits of this resource. Teachers have reported that students have reset themselves and have been better able to focus in class. In fact, we saw such good results that a mini path has been installed in the Learning Center on the third floor of Hazel Lower School so older students in the Lower School receive the same benefits in a developmentally appropriate manner.

This video shows the pathway in action as narrated by Lower School Learning Specialists.
